## Integrating the Environment Management Systems

Yamatake is expanding its business activities across a wide range of areas, from research & development and manufacturing to sales, engineering, services and maintenance. In February 2004 we consolidated the six environmental management systems that were operating separately in Yamatake Corporation headquarters, two in-house companies and three manufacturing sites. This has enabled us to manage and promote environmental preservation activities across a wide range of corporate activities.

In the Yamatake Corporation Environmental Policy, we clearly state our commitment to become an environmentally-conscious company, and our two directions of “reducing the environmental impact of our corporate activities,” and “providing solutions to the environmental issues of customers and society.”

## Reducing our environmental impact

In waste reduction, the Fujisawa factory accomplished zero emissions in fiscal year 2004. This follows the achievement of zero emissions for the Shonan factory in the last fiscal year.

In preparation for the European RoHS Directive, a company-wide project team was formed to create and manage a database of the chemical substances used in our products, which was completed in March 2005. At the same time, our eCOMAST system for managing chemical substances was installed for company-wide usage. In the future we will actively promote the expansion of this system, as well as the substitution and elimination of regulated chemical substances.

In fiscal year 2004 we adopted new energy sources to

reduce our CO<sub>2</sub> emissions. At the Isehara factory, a solar power generator was installed as a power feed device in normal operation and during power outages in the event of disaster.

## Solving environmental issues of customers and society

As a leading manufacturer of measurement and control, Yamatake has been promoting its businesses that contribute to environmental preservation, such as energy and resource conservation in buildings, plants and factories. To support these businesses, we are promoting the model factory for environmental conservation, where Yamatake's own technologies and products are used at our factories for energy and resource conservation and waste reduction, and their performance is evaluated and verified. For example, in developing the Infilex CR HVAC Controller, we installed it in Yamatake's Primary Standards Lab which requires very precise temperature and humidity control. After testing and verifying its performance in-house, the Infilex CR was put on the market in fiscal year 2004.

These environmental conservation activities at the Fujisawa factory are shown to the public in the model factory tour for energy conservation. Over 1000 persons, including high school and college students and experts in this field, took part in this tour in fiscal year 2004.

To reduce our environmental impact through our corporate activities, we believe it is necessary for each and every employee to engage in his/her work with an environmentally-conscious mindset. We will continue to promote environmental preservation, and contribute to society as an environmentally-committed company.
